Steel Challenge course of fire:

Stages consist of 5 static steel targets consisting of 10" and 12" round plates and 18"x24" rectangles at ranges between 7 and 35 yards. Scoring is time plus penalties. Each stage is shot 5 times with 4 best runs counted in final score. Steel challenge rules can be found at https://steelchallenge.com/steel-challenge-Rules-Home.php

At least two official steel challenge stages will be included in the match. Stages are located at https://steelchallenge.com/steel-challenge-stage-library.php

Shotgun stages consisting of five poppers or 6" plates may be included.

Firearms allowed include centerfire and rimfire handguns, rimfire rifles and pistol caliber carbines. Competitors may shoot in one or more divisions.

For centerfire pistols and revolvers, a holster is required and start position is hands above the shoulders. Allowances will be made for new shooters and those not comfortable with drawing from a holster. For rimfire and pistol caliber carbine, the start position will be from low ready aimed at an aiming point.

Divisions.

Rimfire Pistol: Open to any pistol firing .22 long rifle ammunition.

- a. Rimfire Pistol Open. Any modification and optics are allowed.
- b. Rimfire Pistol Iron Sights.

Rimfire Rifle:

- a. Rimfire Rifle Open. Any modification and optics are allowed.
- b. Rimfire Rifle Iron Sights.

Centerfire pistol

- a. Open. Any modification and optics are allowed.
- b. Limited.
- c. Production. Standard factory DA\SQ or striker fired pistols.
- d. Single Stack. 1911 style pistols.
- e. Carry Optics. A production pistol with a slide mounted optic.

Revolver

- a. Optic Sight Revolver. Any modification and optics are allowed.
- b. Iron Sight Revolver.

Pistol Caliber Carbine

- a. Pistol Caliber Carbine Open. Any modification and optics are allowed.
- b. Pistol caliber carbine Iron Sights.
